## August 10 Update:

The 15th Annual Run Through Time is currently still scheduled for Sunday, October 11!

The COVID race plan will be submitted to the Chaffee County Department of Public Health within the next week and will be communicated to all race participants once it's been given the final approval. The major objective will be to hold a positive and safe race experience for runners, volunteers, other trail users, and the Salida community in general, while adhering to all local and state health COVID regulations.

The race courses will be finalized soon as well, taking into account trail conditions and also social distancing amongst racers. This will also be communicated to runners as soon as approval is given from permitting agencies.

I've received multiple emails asking whether there is room for additional runners in the October race who hadn't originally signed up in March. That answer is most likely yes, but for now, registration remains closed. Once a final participant number has been approved by the county, I'll have a better idea of how many additional entrants may be able to register. I do not plan to re-open registration before September however.

I've also received emails asking whether or not this race is absolutely a go for October. My answer is that I'm very optimistic, and will be working very closely with the Chaffee County Department of Public Health to successfully host this event. Chaffee County's COVID rate in the general population has remained low throughout the past 5 months. If the situation remains about the same in the next 2 months, then things should proceed as planned with this event. If our area has a large increase in COVID cases, then the situation may change. Please know that there is no 100% guarantee in this situation, but that as of now, the Run Through Time is scheduled to proceed.
